

Materials

Fabric and Size Chart:

Yardage is for your main fabric with the amount of bias trim needed in parentheses. Sizing is based on waist measurement with finished length given. Changing the length is easy and is illustrated in Step 4 because the pattern pieces are for the top and are extended to make the dress.

Size	Top	Dress
7/8 (waist 22-23")	1.5 yds (6 yds) Finished length 21 ½"	2 yds (6.5 yds) Finished length 28 ½"
5/6 (waist 21-22")	1.25 yds (5.5 yds) Finished length 18 ½"	1.5 Yds (6 Yds) Finished length 24 ½"
3/4 (waist 20-21")	1 yd (5 yds) Finished length 15 ½"	1.25 yds (5.5 yds) Finished length 21 ½"
2T (waist 20")	.75 yds (4.5 yds) Finished length 12 ½"	1 yd (5 yds) Finished length 18 ½"
Infant 18 mo. (waist 19 ½")	.75 yds (4 yds) Finished length 11"	1 yd (4.5 yds) Finished length 16"
Infant 12 mo. (waist 19")	.75 yds (4 yds) Finished length 10 ½"	1 yd (4.5 yds) Finished length 15 ½"
Infant 9 mo. (waist 18 ½")	.75 yds (4 yds) Finished length 10"	1 yd (4.5 yds) Finished length 15"

Infant baby bloomers (size 9, 12, or 18 mo) – 1/3 yard fabric and 1 ½ yards of ¼" elastic.

Extra bias trim may be desired for embellishment.

Note: Having the little "bias tape maker" gadget sold in the quilting section of Joann's really helps if you're making your own.

Embellishments:

Any extra trim or lace, appliqué, ruffles, etc. of your choosing

Fasteners:

4-6" of sew-on hook and loop (Velcro) tape

One button

Scrap of quarter inch elastic (you'll need about an inch)
